Graduates of this program will be able to work with people who have different problems that cause maladjustment to social inclusion or people with physical and psychological disabilities, behaviour problems, or disorders linked to mental and health-related disorders. This program will teach students to create interventions that may be adapted to all age groups, whether they target children, teenagers, adults, or seniors.
